



Green River Pottery Participation Agreement 2024

A3 studio

Welcome to Green River Pottery! We are happy to have you join & look forward to seeing your work emerging from the kiln. As you begin, please read & sign these forms so that we have an agreement and you have an understanding of studio rules, expectations, and safety concerns.

- 1 The A3 studio is for independent work in clay. Your 2-month registration allows for shelf space, bisque & glaze firing, and access to the worktime calendar to plan your 3-hour sessions. Sessions are \$15. Clay can be purchased here or you can bring your own cone 6 (midrange) clay. Firing for your first 25 pieces is covered. After that, a \$7 per piece fee will be added to your next 2-month registration to cover kiln space. Pieces larger than 10" in either dimension count as two pieces.
- 2 Keep attention to your arrival & departure time. Early arrival or late departure, or arriving to work without first signing up on the calendar, will result in a \$20 charge, per incident, added to your next 2-month or class registration.
- 3 Please stamp or inscribe 3 initials or numerals onto the bottom of each piece you make. We prefer your using the supplied stamps, though if you have legible handwriting, that is fine too.
- 4 When working on the wheels, as you wrap up your session, please consolidate thrown work off of the round plastic throwing bats & onto square storage bats. Do not place throwing bats on your storage shelf.
- 5 When glazing, a cookie is required if you're using your own underglaze, stain, or glaze. Or, if you are using more than one glaze on a single piece. You are responsible for making these – ask us for tips on how to make good ones! If your piece sticks to a kiln shelf during a glaze firing, a \$20 charge will be added to your next 2-month registration or class signup.
- 6 When your 2-month registration is complete, please clear your shelf if you do not plan to renew. We are happy to arrange shipping for your work if you'll be out of town. We are not able to store tools, materials, bisqueware, or glazeware. Abandoned work will eventually be discarded, and abandoned shelves will result in a \$20 fee when you return for another 2-month registration or class signup.
- 7 It is fine to drop by briefly without signing up to wrap or unwrap work on your shelf, or to see if a kiln has been unloaded, etc.
- 8 No pets please. Please do not handle other peoples' work.
- 9 While you're here please concentrate mainly on your own work & not on conversation.
- 10 If you'd like to bring a friend or family member to the A3 studio this must be okay'd a few days ahead of time.
- 11 This is a partial list of basic rules & expectations. We also rely on your honesty, honor, & respect for others and their privacy. Green River Pottery reserves the right to expel anybody without refund & without advance notice who we feel is not making a good-faith effort to respect the studio & its rules.

Green River Pottery Liability Release & Assumption of Risk: 2024

Summary:

Being in a pottery studio may expose you to health risks and risks of bodily harm. Participating at Green River Pottery may expose you to crystalline silica dust. This and other ceramic materials, such as highly refined metal oxides and other materials of the ceramic process, may cause permanent damage to your health over the long term.

During your participation at the studio you may be in the proximity of, or may be asked to, or decide to, interact with the kilns, clay mixer, pugmill, or other powerful machines. These machines can cause bodily harm. By signing up for a class, or for studio access, or by entering into a work trade, or by assuming a role such as student, intern, resident, instructor, teacher, production crew, or any other role involving use of the studio and its materials & machinery, you assume full responsibility for the health risks & risks of bodily harm that may result from your participation.

Assumption of Risk:

I hereby waive, release, and discharge any and all claims and damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which I, or my minor children, may sustain or which may occur as a result of my own participation, or that of my minor children, with Green River Pottery LLC.

I further understand and agree that:

- this release is intended to discharge in advance Green River Pottery LLC, its owners, officers, employees, contractors, directors, agents and successors from and against any and all liability, except for their sole negligence or intentional acts, connected in any way with my participation or my minor children's participation in Green River Pottery LLC activities
- such activities may be of a hazardous, strenuous, and physical nature, may cause injuries, and participation in said activities may result in injury, death or property damage
- knowing the risk involved, nevertheless, I voluntarily request permission for myself or my minor child to participate in said activities
- I hereby assume any and all risks of injury, death or property damage and release and hold harmless Green River Pottery LLC, its officers, employees, contractors & agents, except for their sole negligence or intentional acts
- This waiver, release and assumption of risk is binding on me and my heirs and assigns
- I will indemnify and hold Green River Pottery LLC harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense, including litigation, which it may incur as a result of any injury or property damage which myself or my minor children may sustain while participating in said activities
